Dear athletes, coaches, referees and officials,

The Brazilian Ice Sports Federation (CBDG) and Arena Ice Brasil are pleased to announce the venue, dates and information about the "Campeonato Brasileiro de Patinação Artística no Gelo 2022" and the "I South American Open Interclub Figure Ice Skating Competition". The two events will occur simultaneously, and while the Brazilian Figure Skating Championships will be only for the high performance technical levels recognized by the ISU (Advanced Novice, Junior e Senior), the I South American Open Interclub Figure Ice Skating Competition will accommodate the other technical levels and will be open to ISU-affiliated South American countries.

Dates

July 20-23, 2023.

Venue

Arena Ice Brazil: Avenida Major Sylvio de Magalhães Padilha, 16741, Morumbi, São Paulo - SP.

The access to Arena Ice Brasil is through the side street of the *Pão de Açúcar Hypermarket* (old "Extra Hypermarket"), located on Av. Marginal Pinheiros - as shown on the image below:









The competition venue has a 486m² track, with 18x27m dimensions.







Schedule (Brasília time)

The official schedule will only be published once the official entry period is finalized.

Nonetheless, we guarantee a practice time in the morning of July 20th (Thursday) for athletes who do not live or practice in São Paulo.

Ice will be made available to these athletes for their familiarization with the track where the competition will take place, at the cost of **BRL 40.00** an hour of ice per athlete.

Once again, we emphasize that this training period will be exclusively for athletes who do not live or train in São Paulo. Athletes who train at Arena Ice Brazil will not be able to participate in this time slot.

Categories

Age levels apply for each technical level below, according to CBDG (Brazilian Ice Sports Federation) technical regulations (http://www.cbdg.org.br/ice-brasil/regulamentos/).

For the "Campeonato Brasileiro de Patinação Artística no Gelo 2022" the categories are:

- Advanced Novice;
- Junior;
- Senior.

For the **"I South American Open Interclub Figure Ice Skating Competition"**, the Technical Levels are:

- Pré-iniciante;
- Iniciante;
- Pré-Básico;
- Básico
- Juvenil;
- Intermediário (Short Program e Free Skate);
- Adulto Brasil I;







- Adulto Brasil II;
- Adulto Bronze;
- Adulto Prata;
- Adulto Ouro;
- Artístico.
- Novice Advanced;
- Junior;
- Sênior.

Note: Both competitions will be judged using the ISU judging system.

Leveling Tests and Technical Classification of Athletes

For the year 2023, no testing will be required from the PRE-BEGINNER (Pré-Iniciante) to PRE-BASIC (Pré-Básico) levels. The level of those athletes should be decided by each coach responsible for registering the athlete in the competition, so long as the coach is registered with CBDG.

Only BÁSICO, JUVENIL, INTERMEDIÁRIO, ADVANCED NOVICE, JUNIOR and SENIOR levels will be tested. All athletes will be tested through videos sent to the CBDG.

These videos must be sent to the e-mail: teste.patinacao@cbdg.org.br by May 10, 2023.

Foreign athletes can send a statement from their respective national federation to prove technical level at the time of registration.

There is more information about how and where to make the videos in the <u>Technical</u> <u>Regulations for Competitions</u> version 10.

ENTRY PERIOD AND FEES:

The entry phase will begin only after the testing phase.

Period: from May 21, 2023 to June 25, 2023 Deadline: June 25, 2023; 23:59 (GMT-3)

Fee: BRL 150.00 (technical level) and/or BRL 100.00 (artistic level)







LATE REGISTRATION FEE:

Period: from June 26, 2023 to July 02, 2023 Deadline: July 02, 2023; 23:59 (GMT-3)

Fee: BRL 300.00 (technical level) and/or BRL 200.00 (artistic level)

Payment receipts of the application fee must be attached to the Application Form.

For foreigners who do not hold a Brazilian bank account, payment can be made during accreditation in Brazilian real (BRL). For this, a statement must be attached to the registration in place of the payment receipt.

Other Remarks:

- For artistic level double or group competitions, each participant pays the BRL 100.00 fee.
- Brazilian athletes registered in the Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior Open categories will automatically be entered in the Brazilian National Championship.
- On the same form, a separate registration should be made if the competitor chooses to participate in the Artistic Level. There is a BRL 100.00 fee, and the receipt should be attached to the designated section on the form.







In other words, athletes can:

- 1. Participate only in the Open Tournament or Brazilian National Championship (unless the athlete is Brazilian and participates in one of the categories: Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior in which case he/she will automatically participate in both) for BRL 150.00;
- 2. Participate in the Open Tournament and National Championship (if the athlete is Brazilian and participates in one of the categories: Novice Advanced, Junior and Senior he/she will automatically participate in both) AND participate in the *artistic level* for a total fee of BRL 250.00.
 - 3. Participate only in the artistic level for a fee of BRL 100.00
- Athletes who register only for the artistic championship but in three categories: single, double and/or group will only pay one registration fee.

Docket or summary

The summary template will be sent with the registration information, which will begin on May 21st. They should be handed in at the accreditation desk, along with the USB flash drives with MP3 songs (bring a copy for safety).

In any case, you will also be asked to send them by e-mail (esportes@cbdg.org.br) by July 16 for internal organization by the organizing committee.

There will be awards for the first three winners in all categories and technical levels.

There will be a gala presentation for the best skaters in both competitions.
